

ACOS for Regional Commander Support

COMFISCS is also designated as the Assistant Chief of Staff for Regional Commander Support (ACOS RCS), serving as the NAVSUP enterprise interface with Commander, Navy Installations and the Navy's Regional Commanders. COMFISCS / ACOS RCS is responsible for optimizing the performance of base operating support (BOS)-funded supply functions such as hazardous material management, contracting, regional transportation, and retail supply. This responsibility entails implementing best business practices and standardizing levels of service across 16 regions and 98 Navy installations worldwide. Plans are currently underway to realign regional supply operations to NAVSUP's COMFISCS. The objective of this major change initiative is to drive down costs and drive up efficiencies in support of Sea Power 21.

COMFISCS / ACOS RCS plays a critical role in assisting other NAVSUP ACOSs in providing support to customers. This includes:

- Facilitating FISC services provided to Naval Air Depots, Supervisor of Shipbuilding, Conversion and Repair, Shore Intermediate Maintenance Activities, and shipyards;
- Overseeing household goods activities, Subsistence Prime Vendor contracts, Navy Food Management Teams, Fleet Assist Teams, and mail operations;
- Directing local FISC management of fuel, ocean terminal, and regional transportation operations;
- FISC execution of local Foreign Military Sales services; and
- Serving as the NAVSUP waterfront touch point and conduit for the outfitting, training, and equipping of operating forces prior to deployment.



MISSION

The Fleet and Industrial Supply Centers located in San Diego, Calif.; Norfolk, Va.; Jacksonville, Fla.; Yokosuka, Japan; Pearl Harbor, Hawaii; and Bremerton (Puget Sound), Wash., provide logistics, business and support services to fleet, shore and industrial commands of the Navy, Coast Guard, and other Joint and Allied Forces. The Supply Centers deliver combat capability through logistics by teaming with regional partners and customers to provide material management, contracting, transportation and consolidated mail services, technical and customer support, defense fuel products, worldwide movement of personal property, and other logistics services.
