*ACOS (OCS) is there to provide the conduit for integration of NAVSUP support to Operational Commanders. This includes such services as allowance development for combat and petroleum positioning, air channel and transportation coordination, and prepositioned material support. In addition, the ACOS (OCS) acts as the NAVSUP interface for operational exercise participation and support, deliberate planning engagement and war gaming participation.*

## AMMUNITION

NOLSC Ammunition (NOLSC AMMO) serves as NAVSUP's ordnance Inventory Control Point and Logistics Support provider for all activities in the Navy and Marine Corps (aviation) that manage conventional ordnance.

Program management of web-based logistics and inventory management tools, and a global presence of ordnance logistics experts provide front line support and training to our customers anywhere, at anytime. NOLSC AMMO develops, implements and administers Naval ordnance stockpile management policy.

Current ordnance inventory management systems are evolving into a comprehensive Ordnance Information System (OIS) that provides critical "real-time" worldwide ordnance visibility. OIS will not only improve and simplify the day-to-day ordnance inventory management, it will also give our warfighters in the Fleet and on the front lines a critical tool to help them prevail in combat.

NOLSC AMMO is ideally positioned to leverage the very best logistics business and systems expertise available anywhere in the Navy.

## PETROLEUM

NOLSC Petroleum (NOLSC PET) is the Naval services' technical and functional manager for all petroleum programs.

**Petroleum chemistry** combines in-depth knowledge of weapons system requirements, worldwide suppliers' capabilities, and details of petroleum chemistry enabling use of local fuels to the absolute maximum extent.

In **petroleum facilities**, NOLSC ensures the cost-effective and safe operation of our FISC terminals and contracted Naval Air Stations.

The **petroleum requirements** team is coordinating the annual worldwide mobility fuel purchase programs while leading the Navy in integrating its War Reserve Requirements correctly to plans.

Finally, through **supply chain innovation** NOLSC ensures that the Navy and Marine Corps take fullest advantage of the state-of-the-art technology available to DoD fuels.

## TRANSPORTATION & DISTRIBUTION

NOLSC Transportation & Distribution (NOLSC T&D) ensures our Naval forces and their families receive quality transportation services in peace and war. NOLSC T&D serves as manager for transportation related programs including, PowerTrack, SMART Transportation Solutions (STS), Transportation Metrics Analysis System (TMAS), Service wide Transportation Fund (SWT), DoD Financial and Air Clearance Transportation System (FACTS) and Transportation Coordinators' Automated Information for Movement System II (TC-AIMS II).

NOLSC T&D provides support to Navy Transportation Officers and acts as liaison with air and water terminal operations. Additionally, NOLSC T&D develops, coordinates and publishes Navy transportation policy and plans on issues involving worldwide cargo movement via airlift, sealift and inland transportation. NOLSC T&D monitors the effectiveness of transportation providers in satisfying Navy material and passenger transportation requirements including support to joint deployment operations and exercises as well as Navy logistics war games.

# ACCOMPLISHED THROUGH ADVOCACY and ENGAGEMENT

## LOGISTICS PLANS AND VISION

As one of NOLSC's emerging responsibilities, the Logistics Plans and Vision Directorate provides logistics planning support for unified commanders.

The team is actively engaged in providing planning and execution support for Operational Plans (OPLAN) and joint exercises. They provide joint logistics process analysis and work to facilitate integration of reserve units to support plans and exercises.

NOLSC also serves as the Supply Corps Community Manager for the Joint and Operational Logistics career path.

## LOGISTICS OPERATIONS

Fulfilling another of NOLSC's emerging responsibilities, the Logistics Operations Directorate provides end-to-end logistics support for Naval operations forces and to operational commanders.

The team is engaged providing integrated logistics support to the Marine Corps through involvement in the Naval Logistics Integration (NLI) initiative. They work to facilitate integration of the tenets of Sea Power 21 into all operational logistics support processes.

Acting in concert with the NAVSUP Science and Technology Advisor, NOLSC Logistics team represents NAVSUP in the future planning and design of combat logistics support ships, replenishment equipment, and ordnance handling and transportation materials.
