

# **PAPA Working Group Teleconference Minutes 23-Jul-03**

PAPA LANT – No feedback from the PAPA detachment.

CDR Deal discussed a rumor that NSIPS WEB had a limit on access. – CDR Eaton quelled the issue and noted there are no such limitations on WEB based NSIPS.

PAPA WEST – CDR Davidson discussed the issue of SRB re-enlistments. There seems to be some confusion about whose responsibility it is to initiate. The SOP will be revised to emphasize that this is still a function of the shipboard Command Career Counselor. NAVSUP will modify the SOP accordingly.

FUNDING – LT Murray requested that we accelerate the funding request due to the fact that PAPA had identified a funding sponsor. Barb Straw responded with an update to the WG on a brief given to the NHRBOD on 22-Jul-03. The brief was well received by the group and received positive endorsement of the DK/PN Merger. It was expressed that PAPA should move forward, but no funding sponsor or funding has been identified. Next step is an Flag level VTC with OPNAV N1, CNI, CFFC and SUP that will be held in the near future to iron out the single claimancy issues and resource sponsorship.

CDR Davidson, then discussed that CNSP is in the process of completing site surveys for the surface community. It was agreed that these numbers would help support the POM06 submission in Nov/Dec timeframe. CDR Davidson will share the information with Bill Lingle who has been working the issue at the Program level.

LCDR Gage then discussed his unfunded request for PAPA LANT. It was agreed that all budget information should be shared so the POM budget submission can be modified accordingly.

Bill Lingle informed the group that NAVMAC was performing their on site surveys the week of 28 Jul in Norfolk and the week of 25 Aug in San Diego. The NAVMAC POC is Randall Bruce, his number is 901 874 6416.

The NAVSUP Corporate Information System (CIS) metrics were discussed. This database available to all with a dot mil address, please contact Beth Pollock to obtain a user ID for the system. Metrics included in the database are DJMS Error Rates, Navy Cash production metrics and statistics on ATM Maintenance calls. A three-year history is available. In Oct you will need a PKI certificate in order to use the system. The website address is

It was decided that the PAPA metrics will remain separate from the ship and shore numbers and will be reported as a separate activity.

LT Perez noted that NSIPS Version 1.0 is Beta testing in several PSD's on the west coast. He also noted an error in the CONOPS in section 10.3, where a reference is made that Electronic Service Record (ESR) is a part of DIMHRS. NAVSUP will correct the error in the CONOPS, to reflect the ESR is a part of NSIPS.

SOP – We received some comments by WG members to include Sea-Swap and Squadrons in the SOPs. After some discussion it was decided that these procedures are already covered elsewhere, and do not need to be included in the PAPA SOPs. CDR Deal wanted to ensure that the SOPs is a living document and can be modified if the need arise – he was assured that it was.

Barb Straw discussed a DDG 51 Flight IIA proposal that has recently surfaced. CDR Davidson expressed interest in viewing the brief. It was noted that both Barb and CDR thought it was more of a concept brief, rather than an actual proposal to implement. Bill Lingle forwarded the brief to CDR Davidson, and she will provide us feed back.
