

Exporting Certificates in Netscape 7

In order to export certificates in Netscape 7, either for backup purposes or to eventually import them into Internet Explorer, first click **Edit** and then **Preferences**. (see figure 1.)



Scroll down through the Category section of the Preferences window and then double-click the *Privacy & Security* sub-menu. In that sub-menu, click *Certificates*. In the Client Certificate Selection section on the right, click the radio button that says “Ask Every Time”. Then click the **Manage Certificates** button. (see figure 2.)



When the Certificate Manager window opens, highlight the certificate you want to backup or export and click the **Backup** button. (see figure 3.)



When the File name to backup window opens, choose the location where you want to save the file and give it a name. Then click **Save**. (see figure 4.)



At this point, you'll be prompted to enter the Master Password for the Software Security Device. Enter your password and click **OK**. (see figure 5.)

Now you'll be prompted to set a Certificate Backup Password and enter it twice. (figure 6.)

***IMPORTANT* Do not forget this certificate backup password because you will not be able to use the backups without it!**

Once your passwords have been entered, click **OK** and you should get this window. (see figure 7.)
